I have a script that runs fine in a single directory, but will not run on all subdirectories. Here's a list of the steps I'm taking: I'm using a bash script that makes a cpio archive of a directory and then renames it, as: mkdir file1 file2 file3... # go through every directory for dir in {file1, file2, file3,...} # go through files in directory for file in {file1.tar, file2.tar, file3.tar...} # create tar archive tar -cf - \$file # update directory cd "\$dir" # perform all tar archival operations cpio -idm archive.tar # add remaining files to archive for file in {file4, file5, file6...} # get tarball and add to archive tar -cf - \$file # update directory cd "\$dir" # perform all tar archival operations cpio

-idm archive.tar # delete tarball rm archive.tar # delete directory rm -r -f
\$dir 4bc0debe42
